V. Review the Durant Industrial Authority December 2013 Financial Report. – Tommy Kramer

Tommy Kramer reviewed the December 2013 Financial Report for Durant Industrial Authority Fund 020. The Durant Industrial Authority total cash and receivables, as of December 31, 2013 were \$3,905,031.89. The Fund 020 total current and long term liabilities are \$1,615,214.33 for December 31, 2013.

The total revenues collected in Fund 020 for December 2013 were \$44,904.76. The total expenses and fund reserve activity was \$41,229.67. The net change in fund balance as of December 31, 2013 is \$3,675.09. The 2013-2014 fiscal year-to-date net change in fund balance as of December 31, 2013 is \$128,466.58.

Economic Development Fund 110 for Job Creation total assets as of December 31, 2013, was \$5,097,725.04 with no liabilities as of December 31, 2013. Fund 110 Account had a surplus deficit in the amount of \$513,652.54 for December 2013. The total liabilities and fund balance as of December 31, 2013, was \$5,097,725.04. The total revenue received for the month of December 2013 was \$79,762.89. There were no expenses for the month of December 2013. Therefore, the net change in fund balance as of December 31, 2013 was \$79,762.89.

VI. Review the Durant Industrial Authority January 2014 Financial Report. – Tommy Kramer

Tommy Kramer reviewed the January 2014 Financial Report for Durant Industrial Authority Fund 020. The Durant Industrial Authority total cash and receivables, as of January 31, 2014 were \$3,903,602.55. The Fund 020 total current and long term liabilities are \$1,595,764.64 for January 31, 2014.

The total revenues collected in Fund 020 for January 2014 were \$38,442.90. The total expenses and fund reserve activity was \$43,361.98. The net change in fund balance as of January 31, 2014 is (\$9,919.08). The 2013-2014 fiscal year-to-date net change in fund balance as of January 31, 2014 is \$118,547.50. Ron Bennett stated his position that Miscellaneous Revenue Line Item in the amount of \$7,960.50 for pipe and materials used to repair damage to a sewer line at The Tile Shop site was posted improperly and should have been taken as an expense from Fund 110. After a brief discussion, Chairman Tomlinson directed Tommy Kramer to meet with the Durant City Treasurer to correct this oversight.

Economic Development Fund 110 for Job Creation total assets as of January 31, 2014, was \$5,184,864.17 with no liabilities as of January 31, 2014. Fund 110 Account had a surplus deficit in the amount of \$600,791.67 for January 2014. The total liabilities and fund balance as of January 31, 2014, was \$5,184,864.17. The total revenue received for the month of January 2014 was \$87,139.13. There were no expenses for the month of January 2014. Therefore, the net change in fund balance as of January 31, 2014 was \$87,139.13.

Tommy Kramer provided each Durant Industrial Authority Board Member with a copy of the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission Employee Quarterly Summary Report for 4th Quarter 2013 for Texoma Manufacturing, LLC. and PharmcareOK of Durant.
